GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1) "Junior" means any player under 18 years of age on 1st January of the playing year.
- 2) Any player under 16 years of age on 1st January of the playing year and wishing to register as a Junior must have the consent of his parent or guardian endorsed on the registration form by such parent or guardian signing the form.
- 3) Any Junior player whose registration has been accepted by the Association will be a player for that club until the end of the playing year in which he becomes 18 years old, unless released by the Club or Association.
- 4) All other players signing this registration form will be registered players for the club they are signing for until the end of the playing year, unless released by the Club or Association.
- 5) A player cannot play for the Club he registers with or transfers to until such registration or transfer has been accepted by the Association.
- A player signing a registration form for more than one Club shall be fined according to the by-laws* and the acceptance of his registration will be subject to approval of the Board. * WASA \$10.00 fine
- 7) It is the sole responsibility of clubs to ensure that their players are properly registered and eligible to play. Any player not registered with the Association shall be deemed ineligible to play.
- 8) No payment or gift of any kind shall be made to an Amateur or Junior player by or on behalf of a club and any payment or gift shall automatically involve the player losing their Amateur or Junior status and shall be regarded as misconduct and render both them and their Club liable for punishment.

DUAL REGISTRATION CONDITIONS (WSA/WASA ONLY)

- 1) I understand that dual registration is not classified as signing for more than one club but I **DO UNDERSTAND** that I will still face disciplinary action by the WASA and WSA if I register with more than 1 club in the WASA **OR** more than 1 club in the WSA.
- I understand that if I am 35 years of age or over at the start of the Amateur season I may play in the Amateur competition OR the WSA Reserve Grade competition with NO RESTRICTIONS.
- 3) I understand that if I am under 35 years of age at the start of the Amateur season I may play in the Amateur competition OR the WSA Reserve Grade competition HOWEVER once my name has appeared 5 times on Reserve Grade match cards I am INELIGIBLE to play again in the WASA competition for the remainder of the season.
- 4) I understand that, regardless of age, if my name appears on any A Grade match card I am INELIGIBLE to play again in the WASA competition for the remainder of the season.









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CODE OF CONDUCT - PLAYERS

By applying for registration with a Club, which is a member or affiliate of the Whyalla Soccer Association, Whyalla Junior Soccer Association or Whyalla Amateur Soccer Association a player accepts responsibility for complying with the code of conduct detailed below. That player also agrees the consequences of any breach of the code of conduct. These may include, depending on the nature and severity of the breach:

- Ejection from the field of play.
- Fine or suspension by the Club.
- Fine or suspension by the Association.
- And/or legal proceedings civil or criminal for conduct unlawful under State or Federal law. In the connection please take particular note of Condition 10 below.

PLEASE READ THE CODE OF CONDUCT CAREFULLY

Whilst performing their duties as members of a team associated with a member or affiliate of the Whyalla Soccer Association, Whyalla Junior Soccer Association or Whyalla Amateur Soccer Association, players will, as well as adhering to the Regulations of the Association:

- 1. Attend training sessions and matches at times advised by the Club. If unable, for a valid reason to do so, players will inform the Club as soon, as is practical.
- 2. Act respectfully toward the officials of their own and opposing Clubs.
- 3. Respect and follow the directions of coaching staff, match and club officials.
- Act respectfully towards match officials at all times. Abusive, Insulting or Offensive language is unacceptable.
- 5. Avoid individual or collective behavior, which may reasonably be held by spectators to be offensive.
- 6. Avoid all acts likely to incite spectators to violence or disorder.
- 7. Make no detrimental statements in public in respect of the performance of any match officials.
- 8. Make no statements in public in respect of any policy decisions of the Club or of the Association.
- 9. Respect the facilities and equipment of their own and opposing Clubs.

10. Take notice that violent behavior towards any player, match or Club official or spectator is at all times unacceptable and renders a player liable to serious consequences, as is any sexual, racial and other form of harassment, as described in the Discrimination Policy of the WSA. I, , in applying for registration as a Football [Soccer] player, acknowledge that I have, by such application, read and agreed to comply with all Conditions set out on the front of this application as well as the Code of Conduct and accept that breaches of the Conditions and/or Code carry consequences under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Whyalla Soccer Association, Whyalla Junior Soccer Association or Whyalla Amateur Soccer Association and of its Members and Affiliated Clubs.
